The Review Assessment

A Review Assessment analysis is equivalent to a financial review. Using the BCMM® Master Questionnaire, conduct interviews, and compile and collect data to issue a State of Preparedness report that includes a BCMM® scorecard, gap analysis and recommendations for enhancements to the BC program.

Audit Assessment

The Audit Assessment utilizes both performance requirements and proofs in much more detail than the Review Assessment. Each Audit Assessment is customized to the business and applied to specific areas of concern within the eight BCMM® Corporate Competencies. An Audit Assessment is designed to confirm survey responses by verification of business continuity program components and documentation.
